2022 COVID-19 Safety Policies

TNAAP will be following CDC guidelines around vaccination/testing to keep you safe during the meeting.

Vaccination/Negative COVID tests will be required. Please plan to provide documentation as outlined below (a picture on your phone will suffice as well).

Vaccinations/Boosters

We are requesting you are up-to-date, according to CDC guidelines. The current definition states that an individual is up-to-date when you have received all doses in the primary series and one booster when eligible, [as shown below](#).

- Getting a second booster is not necessary to be considered up to date at this time.
- The recommendations will be different depending on your age, your health status, what vaccine you first received, and when you first got vaccinated.

Negative COVID Test:

A negative PCR or home test is acceptable if obtained 72 hours or less prior to the start of the conference:
