August 25 - 26, 2023, Franklin, TN

Resident/Student Poster Presentations

To encourage resident student involvement and opportunities for networking with TNAAP members across the state, we are organizing a Resident/Student Poster Presentation Session in conjunction with the annual Tennessee State Pediatric Conference. The juried poster session is planned for the evening prior to the conference, the evening of **Friday, August 25, 2023**. Poster presenters are encouraged to attend the conference the following day where winning posters will be announced.

Timeline:

- Submission deadline for abstract – Monday, July 31, 2023
- Notification of acceptance – Monday, August 14, 2023
- Poster Presentations: 5:30 PM Central Time, Friday, August 25, 2023
- Winners will be announced during the TSPC on Saturday, August 26, Franklin, TN

Eligibility:

Pediatric or Medicine-Pediatric Residents/Chief Residents during the academic year 2022-2023. Current medical students seeking MD or DO degree from a Tennessee-based medical school.

Topic categories are as follows:

- Patient case reports that have applications to general pediatric practice
- Quality Improvement Projects that have applications in pediatric practice environments
- Advocacy projects that directly relate to the well-being of children
- Research that has clinical applications and of interest to practicing pediatricians

Awards: The abstracts will be peer reviewed for acceptance to the poster session by a committee of TNAAP members representing the three sections of the state. Winning abstracts will be awarded from the categories listed above.

Format of abstract: Word limit 300. 12 point Arial font for the body of the abstract. Double spaced PDF file. Title, authors and institutions are **not** included in the word count. Photographs and charts are accepted to augment the body of the abstract.

Suggested headings: Background/references, goal of project/case, methods/activities/report, data/labs, etc., conclusions/discussion. Submit abstracts to info@tnaap.org with subject line "Poster Abstract" no later than **Monday, July 31, 2023**.

Format of presentation: All accepted abstracts will be presented in a poster format. The poster size is 48 inches by 36 inches. The posters will be displayed on easels, so firm backing is required to clip or adhere the poster in position. (Science project display boards are the correct size, 36 by 48 inches. Please also bring clips or adhesives.) Authors should be by posters from 5:30 – 6:30 PM on poster presentation evening to answer questions from the judges.

A social event with a light dinner will follow the poster session.
